### 2. BACKGROUND:

The "BRILLIANCE ACADEMY" a Senior Secondary School was established in 2015 by a trust named "Angarika". The College is located at Jail Road, Hem Baruah Path, near Jorhat Medical College & Hospital, Jorhat, Assam.

In the year 2021, according to the New Education Policy, we started Science stream and class IX. And in the year 2022, we even started class I to class V. So, now it becomes a complete Senior Secondary School from class I to XII consisting all the three streams Arts, Science and Commerce.

### 3. OBJECTIVES:

The main objectives of the Brilliance Academy are as follows:

- ➤ To promote originality and creativity among the students.
- ➤ To promote discipline & punctuality among the student through participation in games & sports.
- ➤ To develop the qualities of all-round development in every student.
- ➤ To foster a sense of bonding among the student through inculcating of the undying values and ideas of complete manhood.

#### 4. ADMISSION:

A candidate who has passed the H.S.L.C. Examination of the Board of Secondary Education, Assam (SEBA) or any equivalent examination recognised by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) is eligible for admission.

These students who have passed from Boards/Councils other than SEBA have to produce Migration Certificate in original at the time of admission. However, if such a student fails to produce the Migration Certificate at the time of admission he/she may be admitted provisionally subject to the condition that he/she shall submit the same within one month of admission.

### 5. PROCEDURE:

- Only those candidates who apply in the prescribed application form will be considered for admission.
- (ii) Admission will be on merit basis.
- (iii) The Selection Committee will scrutinise the application form, verify the documents and prepare the select list of candidates.
- (iv) The candidates shall produce the following documents in original for verification on the date of admission.
  - (a) Marksheet of Annual or Final examination.
  - (b) Pass certificate, admit card & Retn. Card.
  - (c) Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
  - (d) Gap period certificate from a Gazetted Officer/Head of a recognised educational institution in case of discontinuity of study, and
  - (e) Three passport size recent photographs.
  - (f) Caste certificate.
  - (g) Aadhaar Card & Bank details.

According to NEP 2020, by 2025, at least 50% of learners shall have vocational exposure through school and higher education. Every child is supposed to learn at least one vocation and be exposed to several more.

At the secondary stage, i.e. for students Make-up Artist & Baker of age 15 to 18 or Grade IX to XII, every student will receive training in atleast one vacation and more if they are interested. The entire four year period in secondary school, Grade IX to XII, can be used not just to expose a student to different vocations but to help him/her to progressively build a considerable degree of expertise that a particular student takes should be left entirely to them.



### **GENERAL RULES / TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. As per AHSEC, 80% attendance is compulsory (but our college expect 100%). Students not found satisfactory in this criterion may not be allowed to appear in their final examination.
- 2. Students, found absent, in any examination conducted by college might be fined except on medical ground.
- 3. During college hours students are strictly forbidden to leave the college campus.
- No student is allowed to attend the classes without uniform.
- 5. If students fail to get desirable marks in their respective subjects in the college examination they have to attend the remedial classes later on.
- 6. The parents can meet the principal for any enquiry about their ward's progress or any other problem concerning their ward.
- 7. Students must pay the fees for the whole academic session.
- 8. If any student damages the college property intentionally he is liable to bear the value of it.
- 9. The student who is enrolled in the institution will have to work hard regularly. If the teachers feel that the student is not working hard, creating indiscipline in the institute, irregular in attendance, he/she may be expelled from the institute. The decision of the Principal in this regard will be final. No fee or part of the fee will be refunded in such cases.
- 10. In case any parents/guardian misbehave with any staff member of the institute his/her ward can be restricted from the college. The decision of the principal will be final.
- 11. Students are required to pay the fees in time as detailed in the fee schedule enclosed with the Prospectus. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 12. No transfer ceretificate will be issued until all the dues of the Academy are cleared. The Parent/Guardians will have to apply to the Academy authority for transfer.
  - No transfer certificate will be issued until tution fee for the current session have been paid a fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged whenever an application for the transfer certificate is made.
  - Students must be introduced by the parents or the guardians at the time of admission.
- 13. Students must bring their books & copies in bags. Mobile phones, camera, or any other electronic devices are strictly prohibited within the college campus.
- 14. The college reserves the right to check the personal belongings to the students like purse, bag, without any prior information.
- 15. Students if found roaming outside or sitting somewhere without attending his/her/their class will be subjected to disciplinary action.
- 16. No student from other institute will be allowed inside the school campus without any valid reason.
- 17. Parents-Guardians are expected to extend full co-operations. They are required to attend the teacher/guardian meeting held according to the academic calendar.





#### FOR BOYS:

- Boys should come to the institution in descent look & proper uniform.
- Low waist pants & narrow bottom pants are not allowed.
- Boys will have to knot their tie properly & descent hair cut.

### FOR GIRLS:

- The skirts should cover upto the knees.
- Low waist skirts are not allowed and cannot keep long nails.

Economics, Political Science, Education, Geography, History, Logic & Philosophy, Sociology and Hindi

### (C) COMMERCE STREAM:

English, MIL (Assamese / Alt. English)
Economics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Commercial Arithmatic & Statistics (CAMS) and Finance

- (D) Class VI to X: English, Assamese, Hindi, Social Science, Gen. Science, Gen. Mathematics, G.K. Computer Science, (Elective Class IX & X)
- (E) Class I to V: English, Assamese, Hindi, Social Science, Science, Mathematics, Computer Science, EVS, G.K. and Drawing.

### **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:**

The mediums of instruction are English & Assamese (Separate class rooms)

### MISSION:

### **EXAMINATION RULE:**

- Students must sit in the Unit Test, Terminal Examination, Annual Examination held in time to time.
- Unit Test per subject carries 25 marks.
- Sessional Test/Annual Examination of 100 marks.
- Securing below 30% in any exam. will be considered as disqualification to continue classes or to fill up the exam. forms.





#### **INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM:**

- Fill up the application form with BLACK / BLUE BALL PEN only with capital letter leaving one box between first name, middle name & surname.
- Signature affixed on the application form must be full.
- The extra photograph (Passport size) must be submitted along with application form and full signature affixed below the photograph.
- Aadhaar card must be attached.

### **HOSTEL RULES:**

- The student will keep the hostel campus clean and hygiene.
- Unauthorized persons are not allowed to visit the boarders.
- Except emergency student will not be allowed to leave the hostel during the Academic session.
- Hostel boarder will go out for marketing with prior permission of hostel warden for twice in a week.
- Students should not arrange any functions or meeting within the hostel campus or outside the campus.
- No student should stay away from the hostel on any day without the prior permission of the concerned warden and Principal.
- Visitors are allowed every Sunday to visit the boarders in specified time.

# DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AGAINST THE STUDENTS WITH FINED ON THE FOLLOWING CASES:

- Caught damaging any property of the college. (Fined)
- Noticed roaming outside while the class is going on.
- Found irregular in classes without any valid reason.
- Found with below 80% attendance in class. (Fined)
- Caught with mobile phone, camera, or any other electronic devices.
- Caught which writing anything in walls or desks. (Fined)
